600-700 BOWLING CLUBS' DOUBLES NOVEMBER 8th

The annual 600-700 Bowling Clubs' Doubles Tournament is scheduled to be bowled at Rolling Meadow Lanes, 3304 Zuck Rd., Erie, PA 16506 on Sunday, November 8, 2009.

There will be three shifts. They will be at 9:30 a.m., 12:00 p.m., and 3:00 p.m. Five minutes of practice will be observed before the start of each shift. Entrants should report to the tournament directors AT LEAST 30 MINUTES before the start of their shift.

The tournament will be USBC sanctioned. Female entrants must be members in good standing in the USBC and the 600 Bowling Club. Male entrants must be members of the USBC and the 700 Bowling Club.

The tournament will be a one-day, handicap tournament. Team handicap will be 90% of 425 scratch. Tournament champions will be the team that scores the highest total pinfall (actual pinfall plus handicap).

Entry fee is \$18.00 per entrant (\$6.75 for bowling; \$10.75 for prize fund and \$.50 for expenses). Prize fund will be returned 100%. At least one out of ten entrants will cash.

Entries will close Sunday, November 8, 2009 at the start of the 3:00 p.m. shift. For reservations please call Rolling Meadow Lanes, (814) 838-7681 **BEFORE November 5, 2009**

Teams will bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Lanes will be drawn and assigned by the tournament committee. Entrants may bowl three times in the tournament, and cash three times, provided that they change partners and lanes each time.

Entrants must use highest last year's average of 21 games or better. If no average last year, entrants must use highest average of 21 games or better this year, as of November 8, 2009. If no average either year, male entrant must use 210 as his average and female entrant must use 165 as her average.

USBC Rule 319e (tournament average adjustment) applies to every entrant. USBC Rule 319a-2 (**average ten pins higher this year**) is **IN EFFECT**. USBC rules of play as well as USBC suggested tournament rules will apply in case of any rule not covered herein.

The officers and directors of the 600-700 Bowling Clubs are serving as the tournament committee.

Last year's champions were Dennis Pound and Tracy Maynard. Their combined score of 1453 was enough to earn them each a share of the \$500 first place prize.

If a club member bowls a 300 game or 800 series in one of our tournaments, and if they are wearing one of our club shirts, will be among the members at the end of the season to split this award fund. If we have more than 1 member qualify for this award in any given year, we will divide the prize fund evenly among the bowlers, however as long as we have the funds available we will try to give each bowler at least \$100.
