## 700 BOWLING CLUB'S JAMBOREE AT EASTLAND BOWL, JANUARY 3, 2010

The annual 700 Bowling Club's Jamboree and Singles Tournament will be held Sunday, January 3, 2010 at Eastland Bowl, 3729 McClelland Ave., Erie, PA 16510.

There will be **TWO** shifts. They will be at 09:30 a.m., and 12:00 Noon. Five minutes of shadow balls will be bowled before the start of each shift. Entrants should report to the tournament directors **AT LEAST 30 MINUTES** before the start of each shift. Entrants will bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament committee.

The tournament will be USBC Certified. Entrants must be members in good standing of the USBC and the 700 Bowling Club.

The Jamboree champion will be the bowler who bowls the highest actual three game score. The Singles Tournament will be a handicap tournament. Handicap will be 90% of 230 scratch. The Singles Tournament champion will be the bowler who bowls the highest total pinfall (actual score plus handicap).

Entry fee is \$18.00 per entrant (\$6.75 for bowling: \$10.75 for Prize fund and \$.50 for expenses). Prize fund will be returned 100%. At least one out of ten entrants will cash. Entrants may bowl **TWO** times in the tournament, but cash only once. Entrant must NOT bowl more than one shift on the same pair of lanes.

Reserved entries will close Thursday, December 31, 2009 at 3:00 p.m. Entries will close Sunday, January 3, 2010 at the start of the 12:00 shift. For reservations please call Eastland Bowl, 825-5990.

Entrants must use highest USBC 2008-2009 average 21 games or better. If no USBC 2008-2009 average, entrants must use highest average 21 games or better this year, as of January 3, 2010. If no average either year, entrant must use 230 as their average. USBC Rule 319A(Average 10 pins higher this year) is in effect.

USBC Rule 319e (tournament average adjustment) applies to every entrant. USBC rules of play as well as USBC suggested tournament rules will apply in case of any rule not covered herein.

Fred Huttle and George Pollack are serving as co-tournament directors. The remaining officers of the 700 Bowling Club are serving as the tournament committee.

Mike Knight is the defending Singles Tournament champion and Ron Lytle won the Jamboree championship.
