700 BOWLING CLUB'S 33rd ANNUAL SWEETHEART DOUBLES AT WESTWAY LANES, FEBRUARY 14, 2010

The 33rd annual 700 Bowling Club's Sweetheart Doubles Tournament will be held Sunday, February 14, 2010 at Westway Lanes, 8674 West Ridge Rd., Girard, PA 16417.

There will be *Two* shifts. They will be at 9:30 a.m., 12:00 noon, sharp. Five minutes of shadow balls will be bowled before the start of each shift. Entrants should report to the tournament directors **AT LEAST 30 MINUTES** before the start of each shift. Entrants will bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament committee.

The tournament will be USBC Certified. Entrants must be members in good standing of the USBC and the 700 Bowling Club. Female entrants shall be a member in good standing in USBC.

The Tournament will be a handicap tournament. Handicap will be 90% of 430 scratch. Tournament champions shall be the team that scores the highest actual pinfall plus handicap.

Entry fee is \$18.00 per entrant (\$7.75 for bowling: \$9.75 for Prize fund and \$.50 for expenses). Prize fund will be returned 100%. At least one out of ten entrants will cash. Entrants may bowl 3 times in the tournament, and cash 3 times, provided that entrants change partners and lanes each time. Entrants must NOT bowl more than one shift on the same pair of lanes.

Reserved entries shall close Thursday, February 11, 2010 at 5:00 p.m. Entries shall close Sunday, February 15, 2009 at the start of the 12:00PM shift. Reservations can be made by calling Westway Lanes, (814) 774-4071.

Entrants must use highest USBC 2008-2009 average 21 games or better. If no USBC 2008-2009 average, entrants must use highest average 21 games or better this year, as of February 14, 2010. If no average either year, Member must use 230 as his average and female entrant must use 165 as her average. USBC Rule 319A (Average 10 pins higher this year) is in effect.

USBC Rule 319e (tournament average adjustment) applies to every entrant. USBC rules of play as well as USBC suggested tournament rules will apply in case of any rule not covered herein.

Fred Huttle and George Pollack are serving as co-tournament directors. The remaining officers of the 700 Bowling Club are serving as the tournament committee.

Lee Katchen and Dawn ion are the defending Champions.

John Jacobs rounds out the top 5 averaging 228. Only five places cash in our clubs All-Events competition. First place will receive \$100.00; second place will receive \$50.00; third place will receive \$25.00; fourth place receives \$15.00; and fifth place receives \$10.00. When bowling in multiple participation tournaments, **only the first score bowled**, counts toward All-Events. To qualify for the season ending All-Events Championship, bowlers are required to bowl in three of the four regular season tournaments.
