700 BOWLING CLUB'S 38th ANNUAL SWEETHEART DOUBLES AT GREENGARDEN LANES FEBRUARY 8, 2015

The 38th annual 700 Bowling Club's Sweetheart Doubles Tournament will be held Sunday, February 8, 2015 at Greengarden Lanes, 1583 W. 38th St., Erie, PA 16508.

There will be two shifts. They will be at 9:30AM and 12:30PM sharp. Five minutes of shadow balls will be bowled before the start of each shift. Entrants should report to the tournament directors **AT LEAST 30 MINUTES** before the start of each shift. Entrants will bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Lanes will be assigned by the tournament committee.

The tournament will be USBC Certified. Entrants must be members in good standing of the USBC and the Erie 700 Bowling Club. Female entrants shall be a member in good standing in USBC.

The Tournament will be a handicap tournament. Handicap will be 90% of 430 scratch. Tournament champions shall be the team that scores the highest actual pinfall plus handicap.

Entry fee is \$20.00 per entrant (\$7.00 for bowling, \$12.50 for Prize fund and \$.50 for expenses). Prize fund will be returned 100%. At least one out of ten entrants will cash. Entrants may bowl 2 times in the tournament and cash 2 times, provided that entrants change partners and lanes both times. You may not bowl with the same partner twice, you must change partners each shift. Entrants must NOT bowl more than one shift on the same pair of lanes.

Reserved entries shall close Thursday, February 5, 2015 at 5:00 p.m. Entries shall close Sunday, February 8, 2015 at the start of the 12:30PM shift. Reservations can be made by calling Greengarden Lanes, (814) 864-2642.

Entrants must use highest USBC 2013-2014 average of 21 games or more. If no USBC 2013-2014 average, entrants must use highest average 21 games or better this year, as of February 8, 2015. If no average either year, Member must use 225 as his average and female entrant must use 165 as her average. USBC Rule 319A (Average 10 pins higher this year) is in effect.

USBC Rule 319e (tournament average adjustment) applies to every entrant. USBC rules of play as well as USBC suggested tournament rules will apply in case of any rule not covered herein.

Fred Huttel and George Pollack are serving as co-tournament directors. The remaining officers of the 700 Bowling Club are serving as the tournament committee.

Joe Catania and Stephanie Moore are the defending Champions.

Jeff Prue leads the All-Events after two tournaments this season averaging 246. Ron Lytle moved into second with 242, Beaver Clark is third at 234. Josh Hawley has 230 and Mike Ormsbee is at 229 to round out the top five. Only five places cash in our clubs All-Events competition. First place will receive \$100.00; second place will receive \$50.00; third place will receive \$25.00; fourth place receives \$15.00; and fifth place receives \$10.00. When bowling in multiple participation tournaments, **only the first score bowled**, counts toward All-Events. To qualify for the season ending All-Events Championship, bowlers are required to bowl in three of the four regular season tournaments.
