700 BOWLING CLUB'S DOUBLES CHAMPIONSHIP AT CLASSIC LANES, MARCH 28, 2009

The Erie 700 Bowling Club's Doubles Tournament will be held Sunday, March 28, 2010 at Classic Lanes, 2230 Broad St, Erie, PA (814) 455-2695

There will be two shifts starting at 9:30 AM. and 12:00 Noon. Entrants shall report to the tournament managers 30 minutes before the start of the shift they are scheduled to bowl.

Reserved entries shall close Thursday, March 25 at 5:00 p.m. sharp. Entries shall close Sunday, March 28, 2010 at 12:00 Noon. The Tournament will be certified by the USBC. Entrants must be a member in good standing in the Erie 700 Bowling Club and the USBC.

Entry fees shall be \$18.00 per bowler (\$6.75 for bowling, \$10.75 for prize fund, and \$.50 for expenses). Prize fund will be returned 100%. At least one out of ten bowlers will cash.

Bowlers may bowl two times and cash two times, provided they change partners each time. Bowlers may cash only once with the same partner (USBC rule 317c).

Team handicap shall be 90% of 450 scratch. Tournament champions shall be the team that scores the highest actual pinfall plus handicap.

Teams shall bowl three games on one pair of lanes. Lanes shall be drawn and assigned by the tournament committee.

Entrants shall use their highest last year's average 21 games or better. If no average last year, entrant shall use their highest average 21 games or better as of March 28, 2010. If no average either year, bowler must use 225 as their average. USBC Rule 319a-2 (averaging ten pins higher this year as of March 28, 2010 is in effect.

It shall be each entrant's duty to verify the accuracy of the reported average used in the tournament, whether submitted by the entrant or others. Failure to use proper average or make corrections prior to completion of their first game of their series shall disqualify their score if submitted average is lower than his actual average thereby resulting in a lower classification (or higher handicap). If submitted average is higher, prize winning will be based on submitted average. (USBC rule 319a-3).

Fred Huttel and George Pollack shall serve as co-tournament managers. The remaining officers of the Erie 700 Bowling Club shall serve as the tournament committee.

Tom and Chad Gresh are the defending Champions.
