1. Entries close Sunday, January 31, 2016 at 3:00 p.m.
2. Bowlers must be certified through the Erie Association. Adults can apply for an unattached membership (\$5).
3. All bowlers will bowl three (3) games on the same pair of lanes.
4. Entry fee is \$26.00 per team.
5. The award portion of the entry fee will be returned 100% in awards for the bowlers.
6. One out of every ten (1:10) entries will receive awards.
7. Male and female junior bowlers will receive awards for scratch high game and series in each division.
8. Teams may bowl as many times as they wish. Bowlers may only win one award with each partner.
9. Junior bowlers will use their highest average as of January 1, 2016 based on a minimum of 12 games. If no current average is available, bowler will use last year's highest average based on a minimum of 12 games. All others will use a 220 scratch average.
10. Adult bowlers shall use their highest 2014-2015 book average unless their current average (21 or more games) is 10 pins or more higher, then the higher average will be used. If the bowler does not have a 2014-2015 average, the 2015-2016 current average (21 or more games) shall be used. If the adult bowler has no average, they will use a 220 scratch average.
11. A \$100 scholarship will be awarded for the highest handicap series in each of the 8 divisions. The amount will be prorated if the number of bowlers in the division is less than 10. Handicap will be based on 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220. The winner will be determined by the youth's score only. Scholarship money was donated by a private party.
12. Adult bowlers need not report previous prize winnings. Rule 319d is waived for this tournament.
13. Improper average reporting by any bowler shall result in team disqualification.
14. All USBC rules will be in effect and will be used to cover any aforementioned condition.
15. The decision of the tournament directors shall be final unless an appeal is made according to the official USBC Rule Book.
