1. Entries close Sunday, March 6, 2016 at 1:00 p.m.
2. Entry fee is \$15.00 per person, per entry for the handicap divisions.
3. **Optional Scratch Division for bowlers 12 and Over will be an additional \$10.00 per person, per entry. Bowlers must enter the scratch division prior to bowling.**
4. The scratch division will consist of both boys and girls.
5. Bowlers must be certified through the Erie USBC Youth Association.
6. Bowlers will bowl 3 or 5 games depending upon their division. Bowlers ages 11 & under will bowl 3 games on the same pair of lanes. Bowlers 12 and over will bowl 5 games and will move 1 pair to the right at the completion of each game.
7. The bowler will use their age as of August 1, 2015 to determine classification.
8. The proper division must be declared prior to the squad beginning.
9. The award portion of the entry fee will be returned 100% in awards.
10. First place finishers in each handicap division will receive a \$400.00 scholarship to be maintained in the YABA SMART Account # 9121. \$400.00 scholarships in each handicap division are based on a minimum of 10 entries in that division. If any division does not receive 10 entries, the first place prize will be prorated by the tournament committee.
11. All money collected in the optional scratch division will be returned as scholarships. One in ten entries will be awarded a scholarship in this division.
12. Bowlers may bowl up to two times in any one division but may only qualify for one scholarship in the handicap divisions.
13. Bowlers may enter the scratch division up to two times but may only win one scholarship in the scratch division.
14. Bowlers may win a scholarship in both the handicap and optional scratch divisions, if entered.
15. Bowlers will use their average as of January 1, 2016 with a minimum of 12 games. Those who bowl in more than one league must use the highest average. If a bowler does not have an established average with a minimum of 12 games, they may enter with a 220 average scratch.
16. All USBC rules will be in effect and will cover any condition not aforementioned.
17. All decisions will be made by the tournament director shall be final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329.
18. Handicap will be 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220.
19. **Champions in each handicap division will be determined by total pinfall plus their calculated handicap.**
20. **Champions in the scratch division will be determined by total pinfall.**
21. Scholarship money for most pins over average in a single game for each division will be donated by a private party.
